The Silver Medal whose was the painter Henriette BROSSIN de POLANSKA who came from from Polish stock. She was born in Charkow in 1878, worked from 1909 until 1925 in the studios of Henri MANN and Stefania LAZARSKA, founded in 1914, in Paris and Italy. In 1921 she became a naturalised Swiss citizen. She is known especially for portraits, character settings, figurative compositions, still life, designs for scenery sets and frescos. Her work Le Lac Lemman made her more popular.

In result listings, her name is spelt in different ways. (WZ)
