

starting in mid-800's BC. Definite evidence of Games on a regular basis after the year 832 BC was accepted by every authority without a quibble. One of the most meticulous of the Christian historians, Sextus Julius Africanus of Libya, summarized his own conclusions (c.225 AD) with the following very concise statement in his Third Book Of Chronology:

"Now the first Olympiad recorded, which, however, really was the fourteenth, was the period when Koroebus was victor; at that time Ahaz was in the first year of his reign in Jerusalem."

Another Christian historian, Eusebius Pamphili of Caesarea, expanded the subject with a much broader commentary in his reference book known as The Chronicon (c. 335 AD) written at a time when the Games were still being celebrated at Olympia. Eusebius stated that a man named Iphitos of the city of Elis, who was hoping to end a period of local feuding, re-established an older, original festival which had been abandoned at Olympia. In Eusebius' account, Iphitos announced a 4-year Olympiad cycle in response to a mystical directive from the oracle at Delphi. Eusebius concluded very emphatically that Olympic victors at first were not identified by name or in any special listing:

"...Because of this Iphitos announced the truce...Aristodemus of Elis and his school claim that it was after the 27th Olympiad...athletes began to be listed, those who were the victors that is. Before that no one was listed, no attention being paid to those who were the victors in earlier times. In the 28th Olympiad, Koroebos of Elis won the stadium dash and became the first victor to be listed. From this event the Greeks date their calendars. And Polybius has recorded the same report as Aristodemus. Calimachus, however, states that 13 Olympiads elapsed after those Games arranged by Iphitos, without any of the victors being listed until the 14th Olympiad when Koroebos won. Many other writers assert that from the founding of the Olympic Games by Herakles son of Alkmena down to the First Olympiad of the record-keeping was a period of 419 years."

The best modern treatise on the subject available to American authors is Sources For The History Of Greek Athletics In English Translation by Rachel S. Robinson (Cincinnati 1955). Her conclusion is expressed on Page 33:

"Ancient opinion leans heavily to the view that the Reorganization (or Revival) of the Olympic festival took place about 884 BC."

The Golden Book of the Olympic Games" by Bill Mallon, ISOH Vice President, and the late Erich Kamper, mentor to many of us in the field of Olympic research, is the reference book concerning among other things names (spelling) with dates of birth and (where applicable) death of Olympic medallists.

Following the notice in the last issue of the *Journal*, I have received from several ISOH members (and some other colleagues) information on medallists who have recently died in-after the editorial deadline for the Golden Book. Bill Mallon kindly provided a lot of new information, while some friends, mainly Anthony Th. Bijkerk and Ian Buchanan, have sent additions and corrections to data in the book.

Dates of death are, in principal, new, as compared to the book. Additions and corrections to dates of death already in the book are underlined, as are additions and corrections concerning spelling of names and dates of birth.

Names: Women are marked "(w)" before the names.

For women who won medals under several family names, following marriage, names are listed in chronological order. There are cross references.

When the spelling of a family name has been changed, as compared to the book, the (incorrect) spelling in the book is mentioned in brackets. There are cross-references.

I have not, unfortunately, had the technical possibility to include all diacritical signs, for which I apologize to readers from countries concerned.

As for first name(s), where known (mainly according to the results section in the Golden Book), only the name(s) the athlete was actually called has been listed. Further name(s) is listed when such a name(s) is in addition and/or correction to name(s) in the book.

Nation(s) is nation(s) which the athlete represented when winning medal(s). Abbreviations according to the IOC.

Dates of birth-death are written in the order day.month.year.

Sport: Aquatics = diving, swimming, synchronized swimming and water polo; skating = figure and speed skating; skiing = alpine, freestyle and Nordic skiing.

After the data received on each deceased medallist, is an abbreviation showing who contributed those dates of

death (directly or indirectly).

BARNEY EWELL - Olympic Games Sprint Immortal.

When Henry Norwood “Barney” Ewell died on 4 April 1996, aged 78, his obituary appeared in the April 8 edition of *The Times* of London; a 500-word tribute to an American who had not been in that city in 48 years. The Second World War robbed Barney of multiple opportunities for Olympic medals at the canceled Games of 1940 and 1944. In 1948, the Lancaster, Pennsylvania native and graduate of Penn State University, appeared “washed up” as a world-class sprinter, and yet he was the sprint star of the first post-war Games, outshining even Hall of Fame stars as Herb McKenley, Harrison Dillard and Mel Patton.

Barney’s sportsmanship, exuberance, and super speed, plus two silver medals (100 and 200 metres) and a gold medal (4x100-meter relay) made him a larger-than-life hero to the London crowd. They remembered him at his passing nearly half a century later. A grateful home town presented Barney with a cottage for himself and his family, American “Boss” of amateur sport, Avery Brundage, immediately branded Ewell a “professional” and disallowed the triple-medal winner from further competition. But it was “OK.”

Domestically, in Amateur Athletic Union competitions; in National Collegiate Athletic Association championships, and Intercollegiate American Amateur Athletic Association races at 100 and 200 metres, long jump, and sprint relays, plus indoor 60-meter races, Ewell won from 1938 through 1948 more honors, more titles, more championships than any American in the history of that country’s track and field.

Barney died last year, but his place in his nation’s athletic Hall of Fame assures his immortality!

JOHN HYRNE TUCKER WILSON - Coxless Pairs
Champion

John Hyrne Tucker Wilson who won an Olympic gold medal in the coxless pairs at the 1948 Games, died in late February 1997.

“Jack” Wilson was born in Bristol, Rhode Island to English parents on 17 September 1914. He has the distinction of being the only Olympic gold medallist ever born in that

state, Americans included. After schooling in Texas, he attended Shrewsbury School in England and then entered Cambridge University, where he met his Olympic partner and life-long friend “Ran” Laurie. Wilson was in the winning Cambridge crew against Oxford for three successive years (1934-1936) and Laurie was also in the Cambridge boat for the last two years.

By the time of the 1936 Olympics, Wilson had already left for the Sudan to become a District Commissioner, so Laurie stroked the British eight in Berlin and then joined Wilson in the Sudan the following year. In 1938 they arranged to take their home leave together and, although lacking any meaningful training, they won the Silver Goblets at Henley and equalled the record without being pressed. Their next appearance on the English tideway was in 1948 and neither of them had rowed at all in the previous 10 years. During that period, Wilson was savagely attacked with an assagai (spear) by a crazed old woman who had been persuaded by a witch doctor that this would settle some grievance. On hearing the news, Laurie raced to the hospital fearing the worst only to find Wilson playing tennis with a nurse.

Although they had little time to train after their arrival in England in 1948, they again won the Silver Goblets and then this unusual pairing from Africa went on to take the Olympic title over the same course at Henley. An incredible achievement on so little training.

Wilson retired from the Colonial Service in 1954, accepting a management appointment with the British Steel Corporation. I met Jack Wilson just once. He was a man of considerable charm and his record as an oarsman speaks for itself.
