Code of Ethics

All Executive Committee members are required to sign the Code of Ethics, and to live and work by the standards it sets, as a condition of membership in the organization International Society of Olympic Historians.

As a member of the International Society of Olympic Historians ISOH, I believe there are certain standards of practice which I must maintain. I, therefore, pledge to adhere to the following Code of Ethics:

I will respect the constitution of ISOH. All my activities for ISOH will follow article 2 of the constitution.

I will not indulge in any activity which would, or would tend to bring ISOH into disrepute.

I will not reveal information obtained during personal communications between Executive Committee members.

I will not use my position at the Executive Committee for personal commercial benefits in relation to the IOC or adjacent associations. I will consult the Executive Committee in doubtful cases and seek written approval.

I will condemn racism, sexism, religious intolerance or any form of discrimination.

I will use any funds I receive from ISOH only for activities related to ISOH.

I will not support any individual who resorts to practices forbidden by this code.
